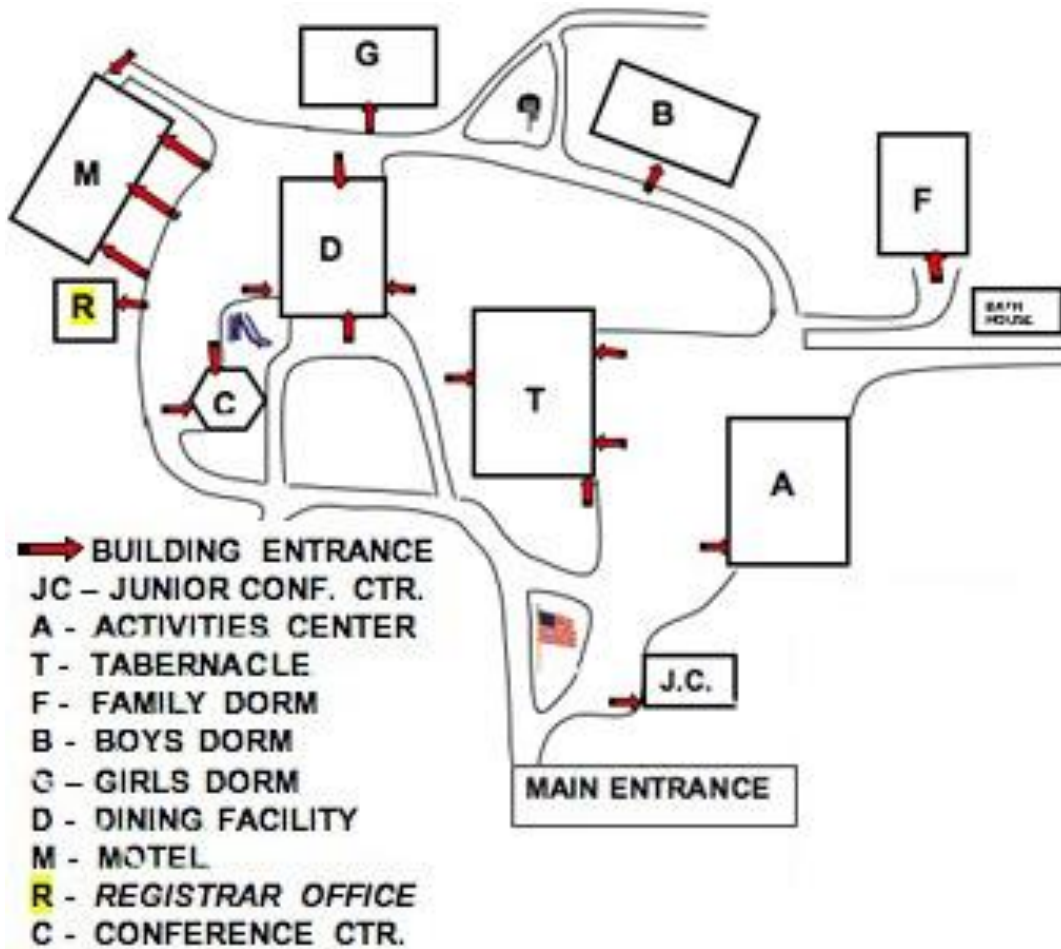

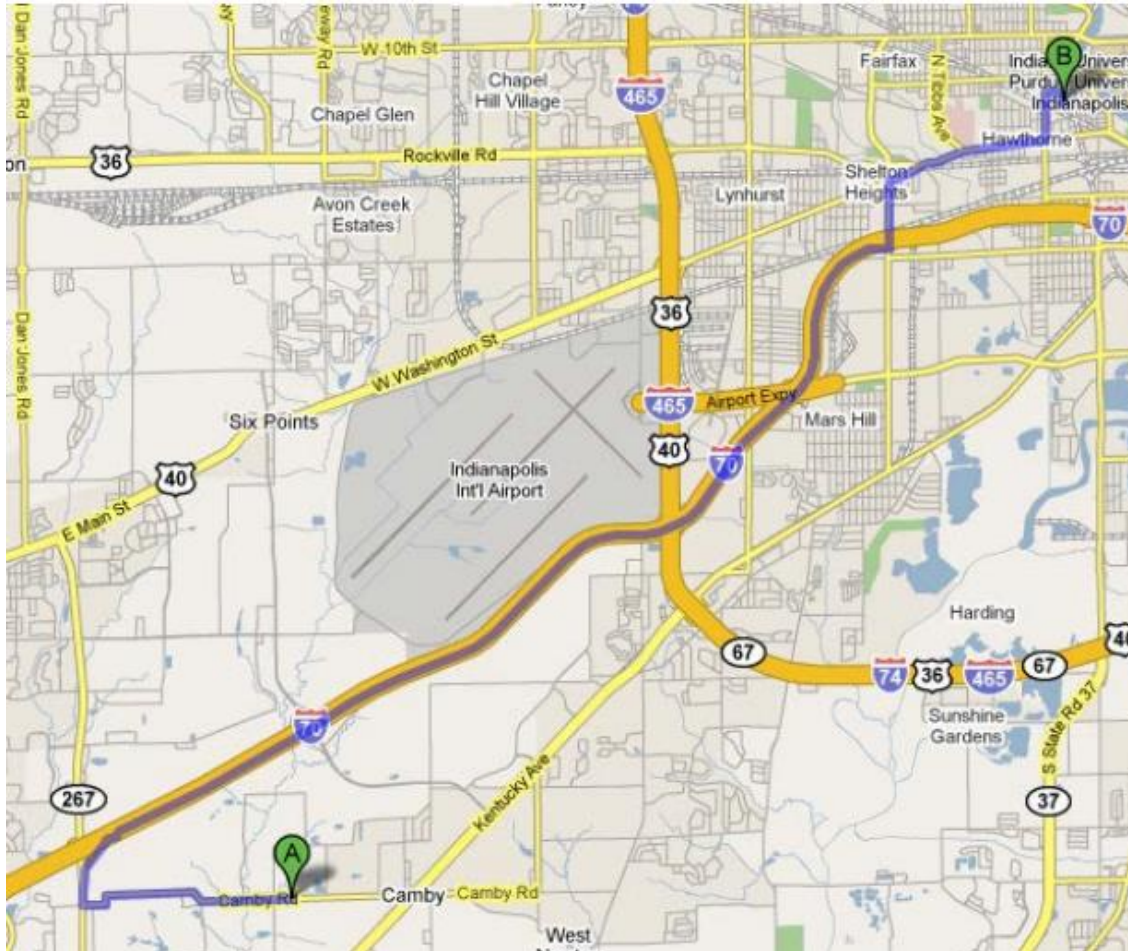
All of the projects are located in or around The Lord's Pantry at Anna's House.

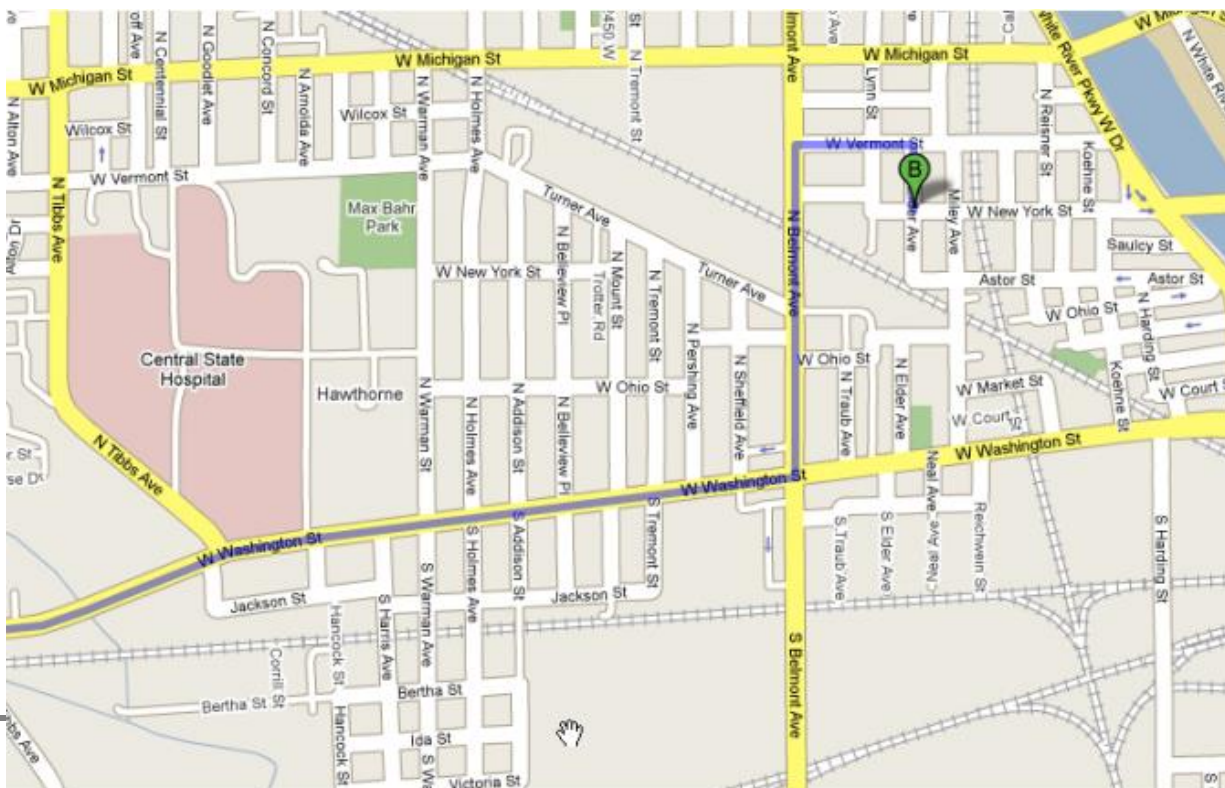

Pioneer Park

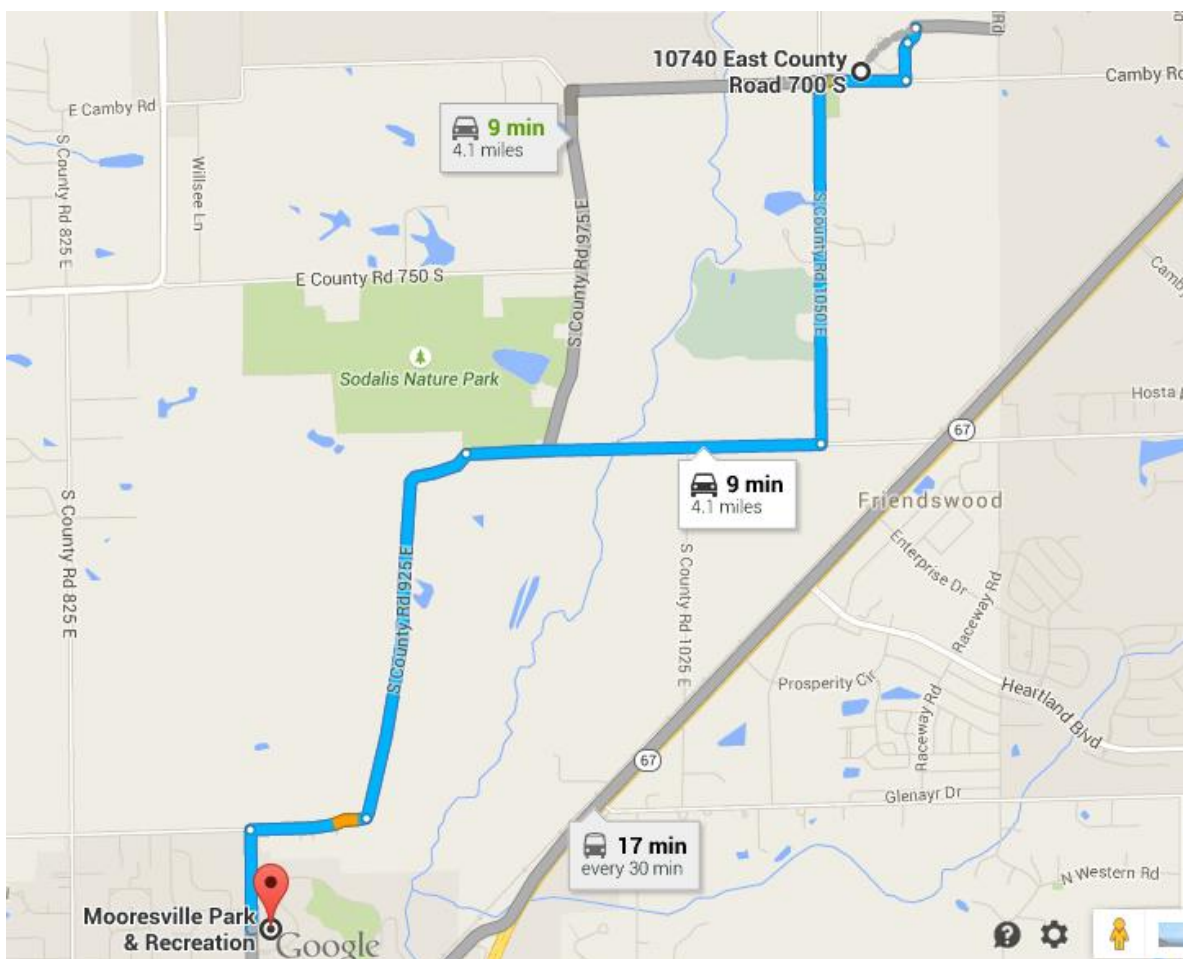

On Wednesday, we will be spending some fun time at the pool at Pioneer Park in Mooresville. Out of respect for your Christian brothers and sisters **please dress modestly**. Please be aware that the pool **does not allow shorts to be worn in the water**. The pool is located near Camp Camby.

As you leave the Lord's Pantry, take the same directions as though you were returning to Camp Camby. When you exit I-70 at IN-267 (exit 66), begin following these directions:

10. Take exit 66 for IN-267 toward Mooresville/Plainfield 0.3 mi
11. Turn left at IN-267 S 1.4 mi
12. Turn left at S County Rd 825 E 1.5 mi
13. Turn left at County Line Rd S/E Hendricks County Rd 0.5 mi
14. Turn right at Indianapolis Rd (Road sign is missing. Turn right after the Saniserv building) 0.2 mi
15. Take the 1st left into Pioneer Park. Look for the pool. (282 ft)

CHRISTIAN WITNESS

The Camby Camp Conference and Retreat Center operates with the intent to exult and to exemplify Jesus Christ to all peoples. All participants and events are to be conducted within the boundaries of Christian conduct as dictated by the Holy Scriptures, as practiced by the Church of the Nazarene and by common courtesy. Therefore, compliance with the following policy of Conduct is mandatory.

DRESS

- Modest attire is required at all times while at CCCRC. Shoes, pants and shirts are required in all buildings except for lodging.

ILLEGAL ITEMS & ACTIVITIES

The following items and/or activities are strictly forbidden.

- The carrying of firearms on the grounds.
- The use of tobacco in any form in any building or any place on the property.
- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
- Sales or distribution of literature or any product without the written consent of the Camp Manager.
- Candles, and/or incense burning or cooking of any kind is prohibited.
- CCCRC has a strict NO PET policy, with the exception of Guide Dogs.

VEHICLES

- The speed limit is 15 MPH.
- All vehicles **MUST** be driven and parked on **BLACKTOP ONLY**, unless approved. Licensed drivers only. Unauthorized vehicles parked in reserved handicap areas are in violation of Indiana state law and subject to towing at the owners' cost.
- Only licensed drivers are allowed to drive on the grounds.

BUILDINGS

- The use of any cooking appliance (gas or electric) is not allowed in motel rooms or dormitories.
- Absolutely NO duct tape, masking tape, nails, etc. of any kind is permitted on the walls or floors of any building. Painter's tape is permitted, but must be removed upon departure, as well as any decorations. Command Hooks are acceptable.
- Camp Camby is aggressive and proactive in controlling and preventing pest infestations. We ask that each group help us by educating and monitoring their participants to ensure infiltrations do not take place. It is imperative that upon any indication; direct location is immediately reported to the CCCRC office.

OTHER

- SUPERVISION: All children and teens must be supervised by adults while on the grounds and in all lodging facilities.
- FOOD: All FOOD is provided through our staffed services...Outside food/meals are not permitted. No Exceptions. Packaged snacks are allowed.
- CURFEW: Quiet time is observed from 11:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. unless prior arrangements have been made with the CCCRC office. Overnight guests are expected to be in their accommodations and to maintain quiet after mid-night. Day guests must leave the grounds by midnight.
- GENDER SPECIFIC DORMS: In order to retain privacy in the dorm rooms, boys are not allowed in the girl's dorm, and girls are not allowed in the boy's dorm.
- PORTABLE RADIO / TAPE / CD PLAYERS: Unless prohibited by your event coordinator audio devices may be used for your personal enjoyment. These must not be allowed to become a distraction or nuisance to others. Radio, tape or CD players in vehicles must be used in a manner so that they may not be heard outside of the vehicle.
